The Patient Care Summary for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina (BCBSNC) members brings you essential information that helps you deliver the care most appropriate for your patients.

You will be able to review a three-year history of your patients' care – including who they saw, where they were seen and the diagnosis code or code for the visit. You will also have a 12 month record of your patients' prescription history, including refills.


The Patient Care Summary Report is accessible on the *Home page* of *Blue e* Log in to: https://providers.bcbsnc.com/

1) Select either the **Health Eligibility** or **Patient Care Reports** link. Both of these links will direct you to the same pages within the system.





- 2) The Health Eligibility page opens. From here:
 - A. Select the **Provider Number**.
 - B. Search for a member by their **Member Number**...or...
 - C. Search for the member by their full name and date of birth.
 - D. Enter the **Date of Service**.
 - E. Click Search.



Note: The **date of service** must be entered for the system to process the PCS report. The **generated report will not be specific to the date entered here**; rather, the report will provide a three-year history of your patients' medical care. Also, information for services may not appear if rendered after the report was last updated (refreshed).

- 3) The *Display Page* opens. From here you may:
 - A. Search for another member through the Search Criteria...or...
 - B. Click **Patient Care Summary** to open the report.

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
